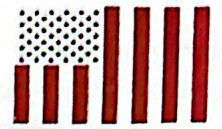

We extend our Honor and our hands in friendship and Peace;

You may not recognize the unusual looking flag illustrated in the upper right- and left-hand corners of this document. That is America's Civil Flag of Peace which was shelved and hidden from us along with the rest of our true American History and Inheritance. America's Civil Flag of Peace also known as "Open Gate" is the symbol of our Peaceful and Lawful intentions for beginning this communication;

Additionally, we are grateful for the men and women like yourselves who have been serving our State by providing governmental services for us and making decisions for us in our absence. However, we the People are now back in session, and are looking forward to coming to the table, being a part of the discussions and more importantly, instructing our employees on how to manage the affairs of our State, its natural resources, and administer the State Trust, ensuring that you as our employees are staying within the boundaries of your contract, The Constitution of the United States of America. This is the government structure in which the founders created for us, and what we learned about in school, but have never experienced in our lifetimes, until now;

2. Legal and Moral Responsibility

It appears that the State of New Jersey employees misrepresenting the "State Legislature" under your leadership and authority have authorized the shutdown of six critical coal-fired and nuclear power plants without ensuring sufficient, funded backup—such as hydroelectric capacity—effectively placing the people at risk of unnecessary suffering. Locations: Hudson Generating Station in Hudson County closed in May of 2017, Mercer Generating Station in Mercer County closed in May of 2017, Oyster Creek Nuclear Generating Station in Ocean County closed in 2018, B.L. Generating Station in Cape May County closed in 2019, Logan Generating Plant in Gloucester county closed in 2022, and Chambers Cogen Plant in Salem County closed in 2022;

Such policy decisions, which appear politically motivated and ideologically driven, may be construed as breaches of public trust, and may violate your duty under both statutory and common law to protect the health, safety, and welfare of the public;

Furthermore, the timing of the shut-down of the 6 power plants with the approval of multiple data centers which consume mega amounts of power and have the capacity to drain and wipe out the power source of an entire community is questionable and suspect to ulterior motives and agendas;

3. Immediate Effects

The failure to plan properly and implement viable alternatives—like rebooting existing dormant nuclear power plants, building additional hydroelectric infrastructure, and increasing alternative sources like solar energy—has led directly to skyrocketing electricity bills and widespread service unreliability;

Such conditions disproportionately impact vulnerable populations: seniors, single-parent households, disabled individuals, and low-income families. Even with a \$50 credit, most cannot endure these monstrous price hikes;

4. Remedies and Requirements

We require the following actions be taken without delay:

1. Reboot Oyster Creek Nuclear Power plant which can produce 636 megawatts of power and putting in place proper pollution protection like flue gas desulfurization scrubbers;
2. Continue to explore the proposals to build four new modular nuclear reactors at the Oyster Creek site that would collectively produce about 1,280 megawatts of power until adequate, proven alternative capacity is in place;
3. Transparent reporting on total energy generation capacity, upcoming system vulnerabilities, contingency planning, and budget line items;
4. Public hearing within 21 days to hear from community members, advocacy groups and The New Jersey Assembly- Land and soil jurisdiction government, who are your employers, on mitigation strategies and accountability. Please schedule this by contacting me at 862-243-9921 or tnja-chairman@proton.me;
5. Immediate emergency relief measures for the most vulnerable households to temporarily offset catastrophic cost increases until more permanent remedies are met. \$50 is not sufficient when price hikes have been up to 100%. We propose that the datacenters can pay for the increases in costs since they are consuming the most energy;
6. Pausing the developments of anymore data centers until the people on New Jersey have full disclosure on the intent and purpose of these data centers and there is adequate self-sufficient energy supply for them;
7. Allocation of funds to initiate new eco-friendly infrastructure projects such as the Quantum Vacuum Electromagnetic Generators also known as Zero Point Energy with patents #'s: US 7379286B2, US20070241470A1; and the "Thunderstorm Generator" which is a plasmoid generator and accelerator that utilizes an annular magnetic core, patent # US3319106A;

5. Accountability Measures

We are hopeful that you, Governor Phil Murphy and Lt. Governor Tahesha Way, and your agents will do the right thing for the people on New Jersey. However, if those responsible—whether elected or appointed—don't perform their duties accordingly but instead, continue to jeopardize the physical and financial health and welfare of the people on New Jersey, you will be held accountable. We prefer cooperation and resolution but are prepared to escalate these matters with more actionable remedies including but not limited to a Notice of Liability against both your Corporate Office and you as a man and woman in your private capacity. We do acknowledge that you have taken some positive action in your respective capacities as Governor and Lt. Governor, and we look forward to assisting you both in strengthening your resolve to comprehension of your delegated authority;

Please consider this notice as an invitation for peace and a call for immediate action. We look forward to collaborating with you for the benefit of the people on New Jersey. 



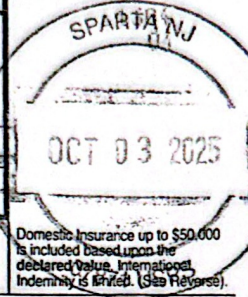
